

Wavy Whale By J.B. Boyles

What you need:

- paper plates
- pencil
- crayons or markers
- scissors
- ∎ glue
- tape



How to make it:

- 1. On the front of a paper plate, draw, color, and cut out a whale and water spout, as shown.
- 2. Make a fin from the scraps. Glue it on.
- 3. Place the whale on the back of another plate, lining them up at the bottom. Trace around the tail fin, and cut out a section above and below it as shown, making another tail fin. Color the second tail fin, water, and sky.
- 4. Glue together the center parts of the two plates. When the glue dries, bend back the bottom edges, and stand the plates up. If necessary, tape a scrap on the back below the whale's tail for balance.
