

Berry-Basket Frame

What you need:

- scissors
- clean plastic berry basket
- pencil
- construction paper
- glue
- ribbon
- thin cardboard
- photographs



How to make it:

- 1. Cut off the bottom of a clean plastic berry basket.
- 2. Cut out the center of the bottom, leaving a border. This will be your frame.
- Trace around the inside and outside edges of the frame onto construction paper. Cut out your tracing, leaving a window, and trim it to fit behind the frame. Glue it to the frame. If your frame has a border of squares, you can weave paper or ribbon around it. Do one side at a time. Use a drop of glue to secure the corners.
- 4. Trace the outside edge of the frame onto a piece of thin cardboard. Cut it out so that it's slightly smaller than the frame.
- 5. Put glue along three outside edges of the cardboard. Glue it to the back of the frame. When the glue is dry, slide a photograph into your frame under the edge that wasn't glued.
- 6. To make a stand, cut out a triangle from thin cardboard. Fold two sides forward, as shown. Glue the middle section of the triangle to the back of the frame.
